SC junks plea...

Advocate Sanjay Parikh, advancing the arguments on behalf of an outstee, submitted that in items of the Narmada Water Disputes Tribunal, the entitlement of the applicant should have been for 4,293 hectares of land. Parikh submitted that a proportionate share of the top court's order would show that the compensation would have to be pegged at 30 lakh per hectare and the actual compensation would come to be Rs 1.28 crore.

Additional Solicitor General Aishwarya Bhatti, appearing for the Centre, stated that the 2017 order was passed under Article 142 and a modification or clarification order cannot be passed as that would be a substantive review of the court's decision.

The top court on February 8, 2017, cleared the decks for monetary compensation for the outstees of the Sardar Sarovar Project (SSP) on river Narmada in Madhya Pradesh by ordering Rs 60 lakh for each of the families which are likely to be displaced.

Passing a slew of directions to address the grievances of 681 such families, the apex court had ordered compensation of Rs 60 lakh per family for two hectares of land with an undertaking to be taken from them that they would vacate the land within one month following which the authorities would have the right to forcibly evict them. Earlier, Narmada Bachao Andolan had told the apex court that the villages and one township would be affected in Madhya Pradesh alone and about 45,000 affected people are yet to be rehabilitated.

The Sardar Sarovar Project outstees, including thousands of Adivasis and farmers, have been waiting for land-based rehabilitation for many years, NBA had said.

106 PFI activists...

Maharashtra and Karnataka accounted for 20 arrests each, Tamil Nadu (10), Assam (9), Uttar Pradesh (8), Andhra Pradesh (5), Madhya Pradesh (4), Puducherry and Delhi (3 each) and Rajasthan (2). Details of all the arrested functionaries were not immediately available. The officials said that the prime place of the PFI is to organise training camps and radicalising people to join proscribed organisations. As the raids, which began in the early hours of Thursday continued, Union Home Minister Amit Shah held a meeting of top officials, including National Security Advisor Ajit Doval, during which they were believed to have discussed the searches at premises linked to the PFI and action against terror suspects.

Rahul emphasises on...

The Congress had decided on a set of organisational reforms during the Udaipur Chintan Shivir held earlier this year. The declaration said that the principle of 'one person, one post' should be followed. Rahul Gandhi is not likely to run for the presidential poll scheduled to be held on October 17. The results will be announced on October 19. Giving an indication of his willingness to contest the presidential election, Ashok Gehlot, who is considered to be close to Nehru-Gandhi family, had said on Wednesday that he is willing to accept any responsibility given to him by the party. Gehlot met party's interim chief Sonia Gandhi on Wednesday. Party MP Shashi Tharoor has also given indication of contesting polls and had met Sonia Gandhi on Monday. He met Congress Central Election Authority chief Madhusudan Mishra on Wednesday. Taking a veiled hint at the party's decision, he said on Friday that Congress is fighting a "machine" that has "captured the institutional framework" of the country.

Rupees sinks to...

A median of Fed officials' projections showed rates peaking at 4.50-4.75% next year with no cuts likely until 2024. The rupee was the second worst performer among Asian currencies after South Korea's won. The dollar index, which measures the strength of the greenback against a basket of six major currencies, surged to a fresh two-decade high of 111.81. The Indian currency started the day at an unprecedented low of 80.2850 a dollar tracking global strength in the US currency. Global investors turn risk-averse due to concerns that aggressive rate hikes by the Federal Reserve to curb inflation might push the US economy into a recession, boosting demand for the dollar, a safe haven asset.

SC reserves verdict...

In their rejoinder submissions on Thursday, senior advocate Dushyant Dave and Huzefa Ahmad slammed the arguments of the solicitor general regarding involvement of the Popular Front of India (PFI) as totally irrelevant, only to cause prejudice. They argued that no material was shown on record regarding PFI inciting the school girls to wear Hijab as a Muslim identity.

In their arguments, the petitioners insisted that unlike triple taq and cow sacrifice, Hijab is mentioned in Quran and it is the farz (duty) of the Muslim women to retain it. In absence of State showing that hijab affects the fundamental rights of others, any restriction on wearing the same affects the freedom of conscience and behavioural privacy of Muslim women. It also hampers their education prospects, it was argued. The Solicitor General had alleged that till the year 2021, no girl student was wearing any hijab. However, an agitation was started by the PFI to create "social unrest" and the students were made part of the conspiracy, he alleged.

Bhagwat visits mosque...

However, Bhagwat intervened to say there is only one father of the nation and said everyone is 'Bharat ki santan' (child of the nation), according to the RSS official. The All India India Organisation is the representative voice of the community of Indian Muslims and claims to be the largest Indian organisation in the world. Iyasi and Bhagwat took turns for about an hour at the mosque, which also houses the office of the All India India Organisation and the cleric's residence. "He is a 'rashtira pita'. We discussed several issues for strengthening the country," Iyasi told PTT, adding that Bhagwat had visited the mosque as well as madrasa on his invitation. "With this visit of Bhagwat, a message should go that we all work towards strengthening India. For all of us, the nation comes first. Our DNA is the same, it is just that our religion and methods of worshipping god are different," Iyasi said, echoing the RSS chief's words. Bhagwat was accompanied by senior Sangh functionaries, including joint general secretary Krishna Gopal and Muslim Rashtriya Manch patron Indresh Kumar.

Terrorists, rapists, convicts...

Others convicted with life imprisonment who will have to spend their entire life in jail include those convicted of murder in two or more cases, convicts in cases which have been investigated by Investigative Police Establishment constituted under the Delhi Special Police Establishment Act, 1946 or offences under any Central Act other than the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Also, prisoners whose appeal is pending in the High Courts or Supreme Court; convicts involved in the murder of a government servant (Central or State) while he was performing his duty; all such convicted prisoners who have been ordered by the court to remain in jail life-long; convicts of offences committed under Chapter VI and Chapter VII offences relating to the Army, Navy and Air Force) of the IPC will also have to spend life in jail.

Gehlot floats Joshi's name as his successor to block Pilot

In a tussle with his arch rival Sachin Pilot (45) waiting to grab his post as promised by the Gandhis over a year ago, Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot (71) on Thursday floated the name of Assembly Speaker C P Joshi (72), a former MP and ex-AICC general secretary, as his successor if he were elected as the Congress President, in the election on October 17. He has already given indication to enter the Congress President's poll fray after meeting Sonia Gandhi here on Wednesday and then flying to Kerala to meet Rahul Gandhi heading the Bharat Jodo Yatra to persuade him once again to better return as the Congress President.

Gehlot wants a smooth transition in the change of the chief minister and he is trying to block the prospects of Pilot getting the post because of his closeness to Rahul Gandhi. In fact, Pilot has been waiting in the wing since past one year after both Rahul and his sister Priyanka Gandhi Vadra assured to anoint him as the CM. Pilot has been sending signals for his ear-

ly elevation as the CM to give him enough time to revive the prospects of the Congress to win the Assembly elections the next year end, pointing out that he had made the party win the last elections as the state Congress president and he can do the magic again if he is at the helm of affairs. Gehlot let out the name of Dr Joshi to be the CM after him as he was miffed at the

TV channels started reporting that Pilot has the blessings of the Gandhis to take over as the Rajasthan CM. He was also miffed by Rahul Gandhi telling the media at a press conference on Thursday in Kerala that Gehlot will have to step down as the CM if he wants to be the Congress president since it is not just an organisational position, but an ideological post and a belief system. Asked if he would stand by the Udaipur chintan shivir decision on "one man, one post", applicable also to Gehlot, he said, "What we decided at Udaipur, we expect that commitment to be maintained." Rahul said he would advise whoever becomes the president of the party that they should remember that the post represents a set of ideas, a belief system and a vision of India.

KOLHE MURDER CASE

Man held from court premises remanded in NIA custody till Oct 1

MUMBAI: A Special National Investigation Agency court in Mumbai on Thursday remanded a man in custody of the probe agency till Oct 1 a day after he was arrested while seeking to surrender in the murder case of pharmacist Kolhe.

Kolhe was killed in Maharashtra's Amravati city on June 21 after he shared on social media a post purportedly supporting suspended Bharatiya Janata Party spokesperson Nupur Sharma over her controversial remarks about Prophet Mohammed.

Shaheem Firoz Ahmed (22), who was nabbed by NIA from the court premises on Wednesday when he had come to surrender before the special judge hearing the matter, was on the run and the probe agency had announced a reward of Rs 2 lakh for information leading his arrest.

Minor gang-rape victim walks home naked in UP

MORADABAD: In a shocking incident, a video has gone viral on social media wherein a 15-year-old girl, who was allegedly kidnapped and gang-raped by five men here, is seen walking naked for about two kilometres on the Moradabad-Thakurdwara Road to reach home. Instead of helping the girl, some passers-by are seen standing as mute spectators, while others filmed her and shared the disturbing videos on social media platforms. According to reports, the incident took place on a fortnight ago but the viral video has emerged now. The girl's uncle said, "She was bleeding profusely when she returned home and narrated the ordeal to us." He then approached the police to file a complaint but no action was initiated until he raised the matter before the district police head SSP He-mant Kutiya. Thereafter, the police swung into action and nabbed an accused after lodging an FIR on September 7. The complainant also stated in the FIR that family members of the accused have threatened to kill him. As per Moradabad police, the girl had gone to attend a fair in a neighbouring village when she was kidnapped by five men who took turns to rape her. Hearing her screams, a villager rushed to the spot but by then the five accused had fled the scene, taking away her clothes and other belongings. Additional superintendent of police (rural) Sandeep Kumar Meena said, "An FIR has been lodged under section 376D (gangrape) and the PCOCSO Act. We arrested one of the accused on September 15. Further investigation is on."

AAP, BJP in spat over 'Op Lotus'

Punjab Assembly session to be summoned on September 27, says Bhagwant Mann

An ugly spat has erupted between ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and opposition BJP over the issue of "Operation Lotus" since Wednesday night in Punjab after the Governor Banwarilal Puri had cancelled the special assembly session.

protest march was stopped by police ahead of Raj Bhawan, held banners against BJP reading "killer of democracy", "Congress-BJP killing democracy" and "Stop operation Lotus". It may be recalled that the governor had on Wednesday thwarted the AAP govern-

ment's move to summon a special session to bring a confidence motion in his favour, saying that he had sought legal advice on the issue and the House rules did not allow such a motion.

On Thursday the AAP legislators took part in a protest march against the governor's decision to cancel the session while the BJP held a counter-protest against what it termed as 'AAP's theatrics to hide its fail-

ures".

Prior to AAP MLAs' march to Raj Bhawan - the governor's residence - Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann convened a Cabinet meeting following which he announced that the session would now be held on September 27 with a revised list of business.

Mann further said that the AAP would also move the Supreme Court against the "arbitrary and anti-democratic decision" of the governor to cancel the session.

Mann also accused opposition parties, Congress and Shiromani Akali Dal of being hand in glove with BJP in BJP's Operation Lotus.

Prior to the Cabinet meeting Mann held a meeting with AAP MLAs to discuss the party's strategy and decided to take out a march to Raj Bhawan to register their protest.

The AAP MLAs, whose

names are listed below, were seen participating in the march.

Gujarat government shuts down RTI request in Bilkis Bano case

Activist seeks terms of reference of panel that freed 11 convicts

The Gujarat government has flatly declined to disclose the terms of reference of the committee that recommended the remissions to the murderers and rapists in the 2002 Bilkis Bano case and claimed that this did not constitute an RTI application under the Right to Information (RTI) Act. An application under the RTI was filed by Pankti Jog, convener of the Mahiti Adhikar Gujarat Panel (Gujarat Initiative on RTI), seeking information of the terms of reference of all the district-level remission committees to consider releasing convicts constituted by the government for the past five years.

She also sought certified copies of the minutes of all the meetings held by the committees during that period, besides asking for the names recommended for release as well as the reasons given for such remission. Jog's application also sought certified copies of the notes on the related files along with the "criteria for selection of members of the remission committee for release of jail inmates on the occasion of the 75th Anniversary of Independence". In its reply in Gujarati to the RTI application in English, the Home Department replied: "The information you have sought doesn't fall under the definition of information under Section 2 (b) of the RTI Act, 2005, and so there is no question of giving any information."



"Everything I have asked falls under the definition of information under Section 2 (b) of the RTI Act, 2005, and I am shocked at such a reply from the Home Department," Jog told the Free Press Journal.

Jog called the reply "ridiculous" and said she would file an appeal challenging it on Friday. The 11 convicts were released under the state remission policy on August 15. After they came out, various rights-wing organisations felicitated them. Bilkis was gang-raped and several people of her family, including her three-year-old daughter, were killed when they were trying to flee from her native Randhikpur during the post-Godhra riots of 2002.

NIT prof named in suicide note goes on leave

KOZHIMKODE: NIT director Prasad Krishnakumar, whose name figured in the suicide note of Agin S Prasad, student of Lovely Professional University, Jalandhar, leading to protests at both campuses, has gone on leave, the university informed striking students in an email. The email message, however, said the professor took leave so that he can go to Suratkhali NIT in Karnataka, which he is also in charge of and that it is a temporary arrangement. Meanwhile, protests have continued on the NIT campus, demanding action against Prof. Krishna. A protest by Muslim Students Federation even turned violent. Students Federation of India also staged a protest demanding the director's removal.

BJP spent over Rs 340 cr on poll campaign in 5 states

NEW DELHI: The Bharatiya Janata Party spent over Rs 340 crore in the assembly polls in five states held earlier this year, while the Congress shelled out more than Rs 194 crore for its campaigning in these states, according to the election expenditure reports of the two parties. According to the report filed by the BJP and put in public domain by the Election Commission, the party spent more than Rs 340 crore on its campaigns for the Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Manipur, Goa and Punjab assembly elections held earlier this year. The BJP's spending report showed that it spent over Rs 221 crore in Uttar Pradesh, over Rs 23 crore in Manipur, Rs 43.67 crore in Uttarakhand, more than Rs 36 crore in Punjab and Rs 19 crore in Goa.

SC reserves verdict...

In their rejoinder submissions on Thursday, senior advocate Dushyant Dave and Huzefa Ahmadi slammed the arguments of the solicitor general regarding involvement of the Popular Front of India (PFI) as totally irrelevant, only to cause prejudice. They argued that no material was shown on record regarding PFI inciting the school girls to wear Hijab as a Muslim identity.

In their arguments, the petitioners insisted that unlike triple talaq and cow sacrifice, Hijab is mentioned in Quran and it is the farz (duty) of the Muslim women to retain it. In absence of State showing that hijab affects the fundamental rights of others, any restriction on wearing the same affects the freedom of conscience and behavioural privacy of Muslim women. It also hampers their education prospects, it was argued. The Solicitor General had alleged that till the year 2021, no girl student was wearing any hijab. However, an agitation was started by the PFI to create "social unrest" and the students were made part of the conspiracy, he alleged.

Bhagwat visits mosque...

However, Bhagwat intervened to say there is only one father of the nation and said everyone is 'Bharat ki sardar' (child of the nation), according to the RSS official. The All India Imam Organisation is the representative voice of the community of Indian imams and claims to be the largest imam organisation in the world. Ilyasi and Bhagwat held talks for about an hour at the mosque, which also houses the office of the All India Imam Organisation and the cleric's residence. "He is 'rashtra pita'. We discussed several issues for strengthening the country," Ilyasi told PTI, adding that Bhagwat had visited the mosque as well as madrasas on his invitation. "With this visit of Bhagwat, a message should go that we all want to work towards strengthening India. For all of us, the nation comes first. Our Dharma is the same, it is just that our religion and method of worshipping god are different," Ilyasi said, echoing RSS chief's words. Bhagwat was accompanied by senior Sangh functionaries, including joint general secretary Krishna Gopal and Muslim Rashtriya Manch patron Dresh Kumar.

Terrorists, rapists, convicts...
