Trump warns iPhones...

For these plants Apple has signed contract with manufacturers, such as Foxconn and Tata Group to set up production units.

In the last fiscal year, Apple produced USD 22 billion worth of iPhones in India in the 12 months through March 2025, which is a huge 60 per cent jump from the prior year.

Apple manufactured approximately 40-45 million iPhones in India in 2024, accounting for 18-20 per cent of its global output.

Of this, about 15 million were exported to the US, 13 million to other international markets, and about 12 million were sold in the Indian market. In January 2025, Apple achieved an 11th consecutive quarterly revenue record in India, with iPhone sales estimated at USD 10 billion in 2024.

Post wife's death...

According to police, the deceased was identified as Bablesh alias Bablu Tandan and his son as Harman Tandan, residents of Goma Ki Phel. His family members said that Bablu hanged himself after poisoning his son Harman.

Bablu had also left a suicide note stating: "Doctors told me I have blood cancer. I don't have much time left. After I die, who will look after my son? That's why I'm taking him with me."

The incident came to light when Bablu's younger brother returned home and found him hanging, with the body of his nephew lying nearby. Their blind father, who was in the same room, remained oblivious of what had happened as he could not see and also because he was listening to loud music.

Will die of hunger...

A rattled Islamabad has been urging New Delhi to reconsider its decision of putting IWT into abeyance with the National Security Committee (NSC) of Pakistan and country's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar making threatening and baseless statements over the past few weeks.

However, invoking its national security prerogative, India has made it clear that the treaty will remain in abeyance until Islamabad "credibly and irrevocably" ends its support for cross-border terrorism. The move was endorsed by the Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS), the apex decision-making body on strategic affairs, immediately after the Pahalgam terror attack, marking the first time New Delhi has hit pause on the World Bank-brokered agreement.

Moreover, strict surveillance measures are being implemented. Use of drones near the event venue has been restricted and intensive checking drives are being conducted at all entry and exit points of Bhopal. Police teams are thoroughly checking vehicles to prevent any security breaches.

Countries which fail to address deficiencies in their regimes to counter money laundering, terrorist financing, and are under increased monitoring, are placed in the grey list of FATF.

Everyone agrees that there is a need to rein them in or else the country may slide faster into the kind of chaos being witnessed in many central African nations.

The rumours of "Yunus out" started after a meeting between the three service chiefs and Prof Yunus and his top aides earlier this week, which in turn was preceded by a meeting of all divisional commanders and later a public meeting of all serving army officers addressed by General Waker Uz Zaman, the army chief and the man of the moment.

Army officer, 23, dies...

"Demonstrating remarkable presence of mind, selfless leadership and unwavering commitment to his team, Lt Shashank Tiwari instinctively leapt into the treacherous waters to save the Agniveer, without a moment of hesitation. Another soldier Naik Pukar Katel also followed immediately in support. Together, they managed to rescue the drowning Agniveer," the official said.

However, Lt Tiwari was swept away by the forceful current. Despite desperate efforts by his patrol, his body was recovered 800 metres downstream by around 11:30 am, he added.

Op Sindoor: Pak army...

Multiple camps, including those in the Sawai Nala area and Syedna Bilal Camp, were destroyed in the attack, eliminating more than 100 terrorists and decimating two key launch pads. In another intercepted communication shared by the Indian Army with IANS, junior Pakistani officers could be heard saying: "Our commander sahab escaped with great difficulty. He's offering namaz in a mosque. He's sent his men here and said he will return only when things calm down." The panic was compounded by casualties within the Pakistani Army.

Is 1991 India-Pakistan pact reason, BJP asks Rahul

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's repeated attacks on External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar on allegedly informing Pakistan about Operation Sindoor on Friday elicited a strong response from BJP MP Nishikant Dubey who lashed out at him and shared documents to claim that a it was a government supported by the Congress which had in 1991 signed an agreement with Pakistan to share details of military drills and troop movements for avoiding a conflict.

Gandhi had over the past week shared on multiple occasions a video clip of Jaishankar in which he is seen telling the media, "At the start of the operation, we have sent a message to Pakistan, saying we are striking at infrastructure and we are not striking at



the military, so the military has an option of standing out and not interfering in this process. They chose not to take that good advice."

Gandhi had alleged that giving such advance information to Pakistan was "not a lapse", but a "crime". Others in his party, like media and publicity in-charge Pawan Khara had even branded the EAM a "gaddar" (traitor) for doing so.

Reacting to such allegations, Dubey shared on "X" a copy of the "Agreement between India and Pakistan on advance notice on military exercises, manoeuvres and troop movements" which was signed by the foreign secretaries of the two countries in 1991.

The agreement had noted that the two countries "recognise the need to jointly formulate an agreement at the Government level on giving advance notice on exercises, manoeuvres and troop movements in order to prevent any crisis situation arising due to misreading of the other side's intentions."

Tagging Gandhi on the post, Dubey wrote, "this is an agreement made during the time of your government" and added that "In 1991, your party-supported government made an agreement that India and Pakistan will exchange information about any attack or army movement." Asking if this agreement was "treason", he charged that "Congress is hand in glove

with the Pakistani vote bank" and again questioned Gandhi on whether it suits him to make "objectionable comments" against Jaishankar.

The response to his claims came from Congress leader Pawan Khara who pointed out that although the military agreement between India and Pakistan was signed on April 6, 1991, his party had already withdrawn support from the Chandrashekhar-led government in late February that year.

Pawan Khara added in a post on "X" that "This person needs to know that in late February 1991, Indian National Congress had withdrawn support from the Chandrashekhar govt. Elections to the 10th Lok Sabha had already been announced. For further information, please contact your party colleague @NeerajShekharMp (son of Chandrashekhar)."

EC to now provide mobile deposit facility outside polling stations

Recognising the fact that mobile phones are no longer only means of communication but also provide access to payments to voters and help them access transport in travelling for casting their votes, the Election Commission has decided to Mobile Deposit Facility for voters outside the polling stations.

In a statement, the poll panel said there has been an increase in the coverage and usage of mobile phones in both urban and rural areas and that the voters, especially the senior citizens, women and Persons with Disabilities (PwD) electors among them, faced challenges in managing mobile phones on the poll day. As such it said comprehensive instructions have been issued to provide mobile deposit facilities just outside the polling stations.

The Commission added

that, "Only mobile phones shall be allowed within 100 metres of the polling station and that too in switched-off mode. Very simple pigeonhole boxes or jute bags shall be provided near the entrance door of the polling station where the voters would be required to deposit their mobile phones."

It categorically stated that "mobile phones shall not be allowed to be carried inside the polling station by the voter".

The EC also rationalised the permissible norms for canvassing in line with the electoral laws to 100 metres from the entrance of the polling station. Therefore, it said, "the booths set up by the candidates on poll day for issuing unofficial identity slips to electors, in case the electors are not carrying their official Voter Information Slips (VIS) issued by the Commission, can now be set up just beyond 100 metres of any polling station."
