BANGKOK Crackers unit blast: 9 killed

An explosion at a fireworks workshop in central Thailand killed at least nine people on Wednesday, officials said. The blast occurred in Suphan Buri province, about 95 km northwest of Bangkok in the heart of the country's central rice-growing region. The cause was not immediately known. The Samerkun Suphan Buri Rescue Foundation reported 9 deaths and said 2 people, who were taken to the hospital, were critical.

SAN JUAN (PUERTO RICO) Gay sex ban struck down

The Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court struck down a colonial-era law in St Lucia that criminalised gay sex in a ruling on Tuesday celebrated by activists in the largely conservative region. It found the island's so-called buggery and gross indecency laws were unconstitutional. Raise Your Voice St Lucia, a nonprofit organisation, called it a "monumental step for human rights in the Eastern Caribbean." "It comes as a beacon of hope amid recent setbacks, such as disappointments in St Vincent and the Grenadines as well as Trinidad and Tobago, that have tested our region's commitment to equality," the group said.

WELLINGTON (NZ) 1st Oz rocket crashes in 14s



The first Australian-made rocket to attempt to reach orbit from the country's soil crashed after 14 seconds of flight on Wednesday. The rocket Eris, launched by Gilmour Space Technologies, was the first Australian-designed and manufactured orbital launch vehicle to lift off from the country and was designed to carry small satellites to orbit. It launched Wednesday morning local time in a test flight from a spaceport near the small town of Bowen in the north of Queensland state. In videos published by Australian news outlets, the 23-metre rocket appeared to clear the launch tower and hovered in the air before falling out of sight. Plumes of smoke were seen rising above the site. No injuries were reported.

BEIJING China bus crash kills 10

Ten people have been confirmed dead after a bus went missing on Sunday in China's northern Shanxi province, as heavy rain lashed the region this week, media said on Wednesday. Torrential rain and floods in swaths of northern China have killed over 48 people and forced the evacuation of thousands this week. Dozens of roads were shut, villages lost electricity and homes were submerged due to the rainstorms. The 10 people found dead had been riding a bus on Sunday morning when it went missing in Datong, Xinhua said.

CAPE TOWN Fuel price protests: 4 die

Four people have been killed and over 500 arrested during two days of protests in Luanda, the capital of Angola, sparked by a rise in fuel prices, police said. The protests erupted on Monday over the gov't decision earlier this month to raise the price of diesel by over 30%, which resulted in large price hikes by minibus taxis the preferred mode of transport for Angolans.

Japan relives Fukushima tsunami horror, 14 yrs on

Residents across Japan's Pacific coast rushed to higher ground on Wednesday as tsunami warnings following a massive earthquake off Russia's Far East resurfaced painful memories and lessons from the devastating 2011 earthquake and nuclear disaster.

Television banners flashed "TSUNAMI! EVACUATE!" and similar warnings as most broadcasters cut regular programming to issue warnings and focus on evacuation orders, as tsunami waves approached Japan's shores.

"Do not be glued to the screen. Evacuate now!" a news presenter at public broadcaster NHK shouted.

The warnings resurfaced memories of the March 11, 2011, earthquake, when more than 15,000 people died after a 9.0-magnitude tremor triggered a massive tsunami that tore through the Fukushima nuclear power plant and caused a radioactive disaster.

On Wednesday, residents recalled those events as evacuation warnings were issued. "When the earthquake struck before, everyone evacuated to higher ground so I thought about doing the same," a woman in Fukushima told NHK. Workers in low-lying areas of Tokyo Electric Power's Fukushima nuclear facility suspended their deco-

missioning after the evacuation warning was issued and fled to higher ground.

A spokesperson said the evacuation did not pose a safety concern.

More than 2 million people along the Pacific coast were also instructed to head to safer areas. Many recalled lessons learnt from the 2011 disaster — known to locals as "3.11" — and braved heatstroke risks in the intense summer to reach higher ground.

In Japan's coastal Mie prefecture, a 58-year-old woman died when her car fell off a cliff while she was evacuating, broadcaster TV Asahi reported. A Japan Meteorological Agency official warned tsunami waves could continue to hit for a day or more.

"I was at the same post office 14 years ago," a male postal

Oprah faces backlash over not opening private road for evacuation in Hawaii

American host Oprah Winfrey is facing backlash on social media over claims she did not open her private road connecting Wailea to Kula, Hawaii, to help people evacuate to higher ground after the tsunami warning. Videos are being circulated on social media alleging there have been massive traffic jams across Hawaii,

with people saying Oprah opening her private road could help people evacuate faster. "Why hasn't Oprah opened her road? This could save lives," said one. Another X user wrote, "Oprah won't open her private road from Wailea to Kula, Hawaii, which would make it much easier for locals to get to higher ground. Massive traffic in Maui with thousands trying to escape the massive tsunami coming. Open the road Oprah." Others came to defend her and said, "There's no proof she hasn't. She opened them during the fire. Why wouldn't she now?"

INDIA HAS INTENSIFIED PROXY WAR, SAYS MUNIR

Baloch rebels hit Pakistani forces hard

As the heat rises in Balochistan, so does the finger-pointing at India. Days after the Baloch Liberation Army (BLA) claimed responsibility for killing 3 members of Pakistan's military-intelligence establishment's "death squad", Army Chief Asim Munir accused India of intensifying its proxy war against Pakistan. He said India's intensifying the "proxy war" was a result of its "defeat" in the May mini-war, India Today reports.

Though blaming India for its internal strife is an old tactic of Pakistan's military establishment, this has become recurrent since the rebellion in Balochistan gained momentum in the last few months, and attacks on Pakistani forces increased.

At an army workshop in Balochistan, General Munir referred to India, accusing Delhi of backing "terror proxies" in what he called a failed "bid to undermine Balochistan's patriotism", the ISPR said. Munir claimed "India's actions" were a response to its "defeat in the Marka-e-Haq", framing age-old unrest in the restive province as an orchestrated conspiracy.



Munir's rhetoric echoes a statement by the Director General of ISPR, Lieutenant General Ahmed Sharif Chaudhry, who headed Pakistan's disinformation campaign against India's Operation Sindoor and is the son of a nuclear scientist who tried to hand over nuclear weapons technology to Al Qaeda chief Osama bin Laden.

In a recent interview with 'Al Jazeera', Ahmed Sharif Chaudhry said India's Research and Analysis Wing was "the chief financier behind attacks like the Jaffar Express bombing in March 2025".

The Pakistan Army and its chief Asim Munir's familiar tune of branding terrorists as "Indian proxies" is part of the well-worn

playbook the establishment uses to deflect blame on India. Earlier this week, the Pakistani Army, led by Munir, blamed India for a "terrorist attack" in Waziristan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, that killed 16 soldiers. India has swiftly hit back, firmly "rejecting the allegation with the contempt it deserves".

7 DEAD IN PASHTUN PROTESTERS' FIRING

ANI adds: The Pakistan Army opened fire on Pashtun protesters in Tirah Valley, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, on Sunday, resulting in the deaths of seven Pashtuns and injuries to over 20 others. The protests in Tirah Valley was against the death of a child killed by mortar fire from Pakistani forces.

104 killed, 399 hurt in 24 hours in Gaza

Israeli strikes and gunfire in the Gaza Strip killed at least 46 Palestinians overnight into Wednesday morning, most of them among crowds seeking food, local hospitals said.

The dead include over 30 people who were killed while seeking humanitarian aid, according to that treated dozens of wounded people.

However, as per a BBC report, in the last 24 hours, 104 people have been killed in Gaza and a 399 injured, the Hamas-run health ministry said in its latest update. Many killed and injured were under rubble and in the streets, the ministry said, adding ambulance and rescue teams were unable to reach them. The Israeli military didn't comment on any of the strikes, but says it only targets militants and blames civilian deaths on Hamas, because the group's militants operate in densely populated areas.

The deaths came as the UK announced it would recognise a Palestinian state in September, unless Israel agrees to a ceasefire in the Israel-Hamas war, fol-

Additionally, 7 Palestinians, including a child, died of malnutrition-related causes in the past 24 hours, the ministry said. A total of 89 kids have died of malnutrition since the war began in Gaza. It said 65 Palestinian adults have died of malnutrition-related causes in Gaza since late June.

Rockfall at Pak mountain kills German champ

German Olympic champion Laura Dahlmeier has died following a mountaineering accident in Pakistan, her management company confirmed on Wednesday.

The accident occurred around noon on Monday, at an altitude of 5,700 metres at Laila Peak. Dahlmeier, 31, was climbing with her mountaineering partner when she was struck by a sudden rockfall in the Hushe Valley in the northern Gilgit-Baltistan region.

Her mountaineering partner alerted rescue services and an international team was dispatched to the area. However, as the accident took place in a remote area, a helicopter did not reach the site until the morning of July 29. Rescuers struggled to reach the former athlete due to the risk of falling rocks.

Dahlmeier is a 2-time Winter Olympic champion and 7-time world champion in biathlon. She announced her retirement from competitive biathlon in May 2019 at the age of 25 and has since dedicated herself to her passion for mountaineering.
